## Notice regarding MPOC Tariffs from 1 October 2021

The following tariffs will be charged from 1 October 2021 to 30 September 2022 (Gas Year 2022) for transmission services provided under the Maui Pipeline Operating Code (MPOC):

- Tariff 1: \$0.001832 per GJ.km
- Tariff 2: \$0.083663 per GJ

These tariffs, together with prices to be set under the Vector Transmission Code (VTC) for Gas Year 2022, are calculated to recover regulated revenue under the Default Price-Quality Path (DPP) Determination 2017.<sup>1</sup>

These tariffs represent a 10% increase over the current tariffs. This increase reflects an increase in forecast pass-through and recoverable costs as well as an increase in the wash-up account balance, as outlined in our 26 May 2021 letter to stakeholders and published on OATIS. We are also expecting changes to the volumes of gas transported, as shown in the table below.

Thank you to those who responded to our provisional prices letter. As the responses largely dealt with prices under the VTC, we will respond to the issues raised when we publish our final prices on or before 1 September 2021.

The full Transmission Pricing Methodology will be published at least 20 days prior to 1 October 2021, in accordance with the *Gas Transmission Information Disclosure Determination*.
